Welcome to Minfos 4.1.3

This document provides an overview of the enhancements and support issue fixes in this Minfos release.

In this release:

- In compliance with 6CPA initiatives, Minfos now captures compounder information and Infusion ID's
- A new PDL warning for Fentanyl oral preparations now appears in Dispense
- LoyaltyOne integration improvements

How to update Minfos

1. At any point in the day, download the latest Minfos software.
 - a. On the Minfos Launch Pad, click the **File** menu, and select **Minfos Net Terminal**.
The Minfos Net Terminal window is displayed.
 - b. Click the **Connect** menu, and select **1. Internet**. The Online Menu is displayed.
 - c. Check the **1 New Minfos Software** check box, then click **Okay**.
2. When you're finished trading for the day, ensure there are zero connections to your Minfos server.
Your Minfos software will update automatically, overnight.
3. Check that your Minfos software successfully updated. On the Minfos Launch Pad, click the **Help** menu, then click **About Minfos Software**.
The About Minfos Software window is displayed and shows your current Minfos version in the **Applications Versions** box.

Enhancements

This section provides details about enhancements in this release.

Dispense

6CPA changes to the Efficient Funding of Chemotherapy (EFC) claiming

Effective from 1 September 2016, PBS Online requires additional data for items on the EFC (Efficient Funding of Chemotherapy) schedule. To accommodate this, Minfos now captures:

- The Compounder ID
- The Infusion Serial ID

Setting up a Compounder

Compounder Maintenance has been added to Dispense to maintain details of chemotherapy compounders that supply the pharmacy with chemotherapy items.

This window can be accessed two ways:

- From Dispense, click the **Maintenance** menu and select **8. Compounder** [Alt + M][8]
- From the Dispense window, click the **Extended** button and select **8. Compounder Maintenance** [Alt + E][8][Enter]



To add a compounder, click **Add**.

This will open the **Compounder Entry** window. Enter the approved compounder details including the Compounder ID of the compounder as well as their name and address details.



Nominate a Default Compounder

After adding your compounders to **Compounder Maintenance**, you can then nominate your default compounder.

1. From **Dispense**, click the **Maintenance** menu and select **Configuration**.
2. Click the **Dispense/Customer** tab.
3. From the **Default Compounder** dropdown box, select your default compounder
4. Click **Okay** to save.

Using the Default Compounder

After your compounders have been added and a default compounder nominated, the default will be displayed in the chemotherapy combinations screen within the dispense form.

To apply an alternative compounder when dispensing a chemotherapy infusion, enter an alternative Compounder ID in the **Compounder** field.

Chemotherapy Infusion Serial ID

- Minfos will now generate and apply an Infusion ID to each chemotherapy infusion that is dispensed.
- By default each infusion will be treated as a single infusion.
- The **Chemotherapy Combinations** screen will display any infusions dispensed that day for that patient. Where multiple infusions are required, select the **Add To Existing Infusion** checkbox and select a previously dispensed chemotherapy item to apply the same Infusion ID.

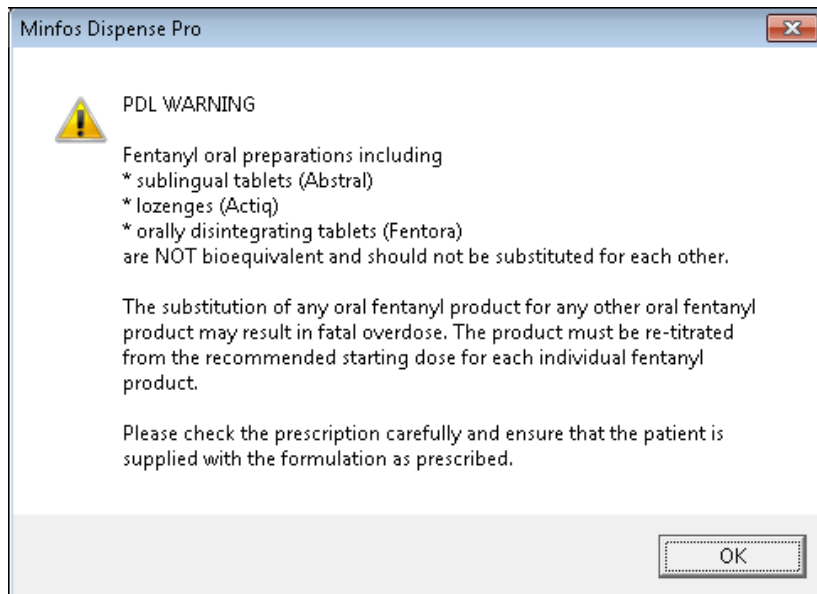
- Only chemotherapy items dispensed that day will be available for selection. If there are no previous chemotherapy infusions for that day, and therefore no infusions to attach the item to, the **Add to Existing Infusion** checkbox will be disabled.

New PDL warning for Fentanyl

When dispensing Fentanyl oral preparations, Minfos will prompt with a PDL warning.

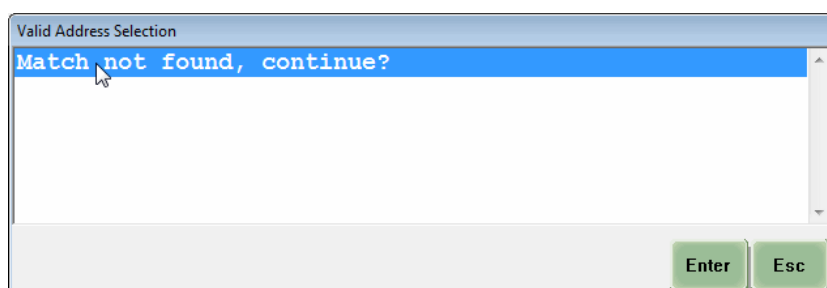
The Fentanyl preparations, including:

- Sublingual tablets (Abstral)
- Lozenges (Actiq)
- Orally disintegrating tablets (Fentora)



LoyaltyOne Integration Improvements

- **Cancel Mode** is now handled correctly in a loyalty transaction.
- When editing a member's details and a match cannot be found for the address, you can now select 'match not found' and continue to save the member's details.



Support issues resolved

This section provides details about support issues resolved in this release.

Dispense

- Minfos now only displays Chemotherapy Combinations that are eligible at the time of prescribing.

Order Maintenance

- The **Price Manager** button is now at the bottom of the **Order Maintenance** window and the shortcut has been changed to **[Alt + W]**. It was previously **[Alt + M]** and was conflicting with another button.
